sell and quit claim unto

property to wit:

A lot known as the  
Shelby Female College lot located  
in Cleveland County North  
Carolina, near the town of Shelby  
in said County and state  
comprising two acres more or  
less, to have and to hold the  
same unto the said W. P. Love  
and unto his heirs and assigns  
forever, and we hereby covenant  
with the said W. P. Love that we  
will forever warrant and defend  
the title to said land against  
all lawful claims whatever,  
Witness our hands this 12<sup>th</sup> day  
of October 1887.
