VINCE CERVERA

Vince Cervera was born in New Orleans, Louisiana. He was converted at the age of fourteen and called to preach shortly thereafter. Upon graduating from college, he received further training at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky. In 1948 he entered the field of evangelism.

For the past eighteen years he has traveled an average of 40,000 miles each year. His ministry has led him to some of the strategic pulpits of America for revival, such as the First Baptist Church, New Orleans, La. (3,846 members), Dr. J. D. Grey, Pastor; Bellevue Baptist Church, Memphis, Tenn. (9,256 members), Dr. Adrian Rogers, Pastor; First Baptist Church, Lubbock, Texas (7,862 members), Dr. J. Ralph Grant, Pastor; Walnut Street Baptist Church, Louisville, Ky. (5,441 members), Dr. W. R. Pettigrew, Pastor; and others.

Yet his efforts are not confined to the large church, but his ministry is equally effective in churches of varying sizes. It is his firm conviction the appeal of an evangelist must be so diversified as to reach people of all walks of life.

There are certain men in the ministry whom God has uniquely endowed, with the divine gift of evangelism; Vince Cervera is such a man. This is evidenced by his repeated invitations to return to the same churches for revival as many as four and in some cases five times. His evangelistic schedule is usually filled from one to two years in advance.

The positive approach of Vince Cervera's ministry is the type that strengthens the entire church program, as well as wins and enlists the lost. He has lead in nearly four hundred revivals, and more than ten thousand people have joined the churches under his ministry.

Presently he makes his home in Greenville, S.C. with his wife Millie and three daughters—Susan, Sandy, and Sally. He returns home after almost every revival for a few days of rest and preparation between Sundays before the next Campaign.
