Mrs. Darwin To *May 1956* Be Honor Guest At YW Birthday

When the Athens Young Women's Christian Association celebrates its fiftieth birthday with a dinner Tuesday, Mrs. J. A. Darwin will probably be looking back over her memories of 45 of these fifty years.

Mrs. Darwin, the local association's oldest member in point of service, is the only living member who has signed three charters. She signed the 1910, 1926 and 1954 charters.

She is past president of the board and has headed most of the committees during her years of service. She was honored by the State Conference of Georgia Employed Women of the YWCA in 1954 when they met in Athens at the Jennie Arnold Edwards Camp.

The Edweda Club, newest of the YWCA's business women's clubs, derives its name from the first two letters of Mrs. Darwin's first, middle and last names — Edna Webb Darwin.
