Dear Mrs. Riley -

Monday night I
called Mrs Edwin Webb on the
phone to discuss "Family
History with her, she told
me that you might help
me out with my line. About
eleven years ago, I wrote
Judge Webb, and his reply
led me to believe it might
be the same line. My
great grandfather was Clinton
Webb, who married a Robinson.
They came to Ga from

Rutherford County, as I've been told.
The Indians were still in this part of
Ga. There has never been any record
kept and I just want to establish
the line. Judge Webb wrote me that
he had a truck by the name of
Clinton Webb. Clinton Webb's father
was Robert Webb and he married
Mildred Clinton and that is
all I know. I have a book

on the Webb family gotten out
by Mr Stewart of Louisville Ky,
and he leaves two Webbs in
N.C. in 1747. One reason that
I did not follow it up was
that I expected to go to your
part of the Country to investigate
other lines. The Logan line - my
grand mother Webb was Mary Mitchell
Logan. Her father was James Logan and
her mother was Sara Lankford - daughter
of Nathan Lankford and - Caldwell of
Buncombe Co. N.C. All my people came
from N.C. I will appreciate any
information you can give me on the
Webbs.
