Whitehaven 6th Jan 4 1772

I wrote you sometime ago, concerning
a letter from Mr Thomas Gilchrist, in Virginia
acquainting you he had sent a cask of Wine to my
care, for you, I intended to sent it to Dumfries, by a
Vessel that was then there, but could not get it land
ed in time, and as I should be unwilling to get it sent
to you by the next opportunity, I have now I suppose
it ordered Cap. Mordaunt for Whitehead to be care
of Messrs McPharlane, who will take care of it till
you can send for it, and hope will get in 2 or 3 days
any more respectful Compliments attend on it
I am with the complements of the season
and many happy returns
