(Pg. 9 and 92 - Griffin's History of Old Tuxon)  
Soldier's names of Rutherford Co.  
in the Revolution (after many years  
of painstaking research these names  
have been unearthed)

Burrell Blanton. Enlisted as a  
private in Capt. Merrill's Co. and  
served in Capt. Jos. Earle's Co.  
N.C. militia in 1783. Born in  
Va. in 1762 a son of Geo. Blanton.  
married Chorra (Lu) - Died 1860

Pg. 151 - Commissioners signing an act  
of Assembly passed in Raleigh Nov. 18  
1799 was George Blanton from  
town of Jefferson.

Pg. 156 - War of 1812. - From roster rolls of  
four Rutherford Companies copied for  
"The Muster Rolls of Soldiers of War of 1812"  
published under direction of Adj. Gen. of N.C.  
10th Co. detached from 2nd Rutherford Regiment  
(53 men and officers) George Blanton
