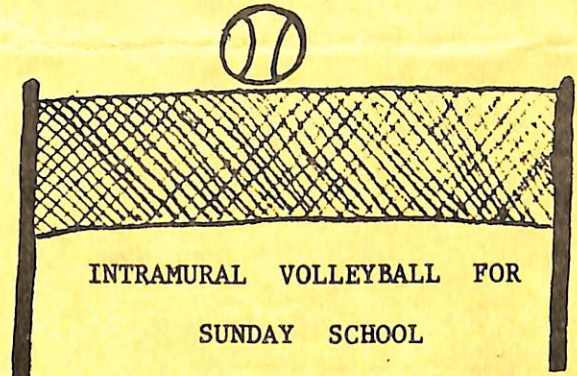
### ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE ELECTED

### Volleyball Rules

1. All matches will consist of the best 2 out of 3 games.
2. At least one-third of the players on the court at any time during the game must be women or girls.
3. A player may not go into the net, over the net, or under the net whatsoever. A player may step on the center line or back court line when serving, BUT NEVER OVER IT.
4. Eligibility: Any person on your Sunday School Roll is eligible to play. Also any prospect for your class is eligible.
5. A minimum of 4 players must be present or game will be forfeited. As many as 9 players may play on the court at one time. Any number of subs may be on the side lines players' bench and rotate into the game.

Let's have a large turn out for the games and build a great fellowship in our class and in our church. We will reach many people for the Lord through this form of Christian recreation.
