- 2 - Jones Robertson, Justice, as was Watson and Blanton ancestry - He was the father of Rebecca & May Tom or Capt Wm Robertson (?)
- 3 - militia of Tryon, later Rutherford and Lincoln were enrolled in the "north" of District of Salisbury.

- 9- Wm Watson & Jas Robertson refused the bond for \$1000 Mrs Proclamation money for Thos. Hall when appointed Public Register at the Oct. 1771 term of court. (County first register)
