Funeral services were held this morning at 10:30 o'clock at the First Baptist church for George Milton Webb, member of a prominent Cleveland county family who died at his home in Birmingham, Ala. at four o'clock Saturday afternoon.

Mr. Webb was born and reared in Cleveland county, the son of the late Rev. G. M. Webb and Mrs. Priscilla Jane Webb. He was 81 years of age and had been living in Birmingham for 35 years where he was a prominent business man, engaged in the sale of real estate and insurance. He was married to Miss Margaret Blanton who died some years ago. She was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Burwell H. Blanton and a sister of Charles C. and George Blanton, of Shelby and Edgar Blanton, of Asheville.

The remains were brought to Shelby Sunday night for funeral here and interment in Sunset cemetery beside his deceased wife.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. John B. Oates of Charlotte, one son, Charles B. Webb of Birmingham, three grandchildren, a brother, Judge E. Y. Webb of Shelby and a sister, Mrs. John A. Darwin, of Athens, Ga.
