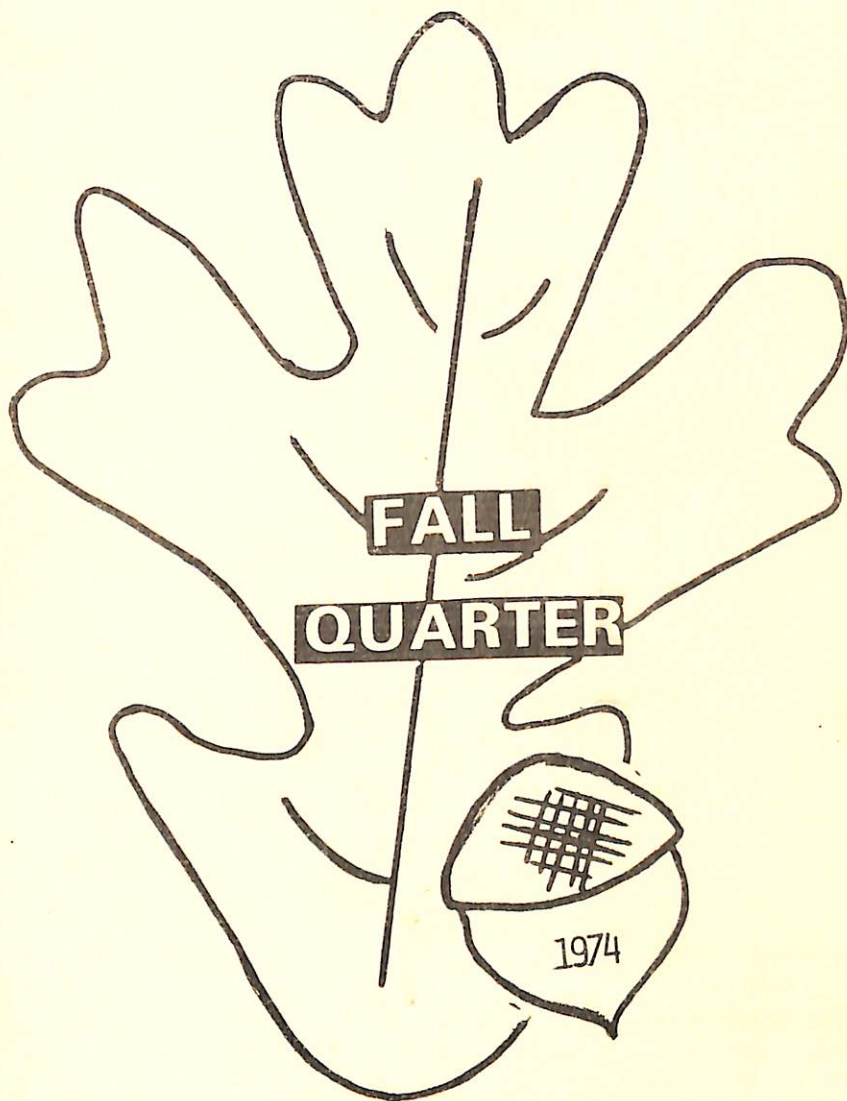

Date: Every Saturday 9:30 a.m.-12:00 noon

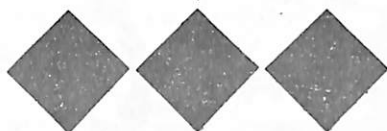

Class limit: 12 people

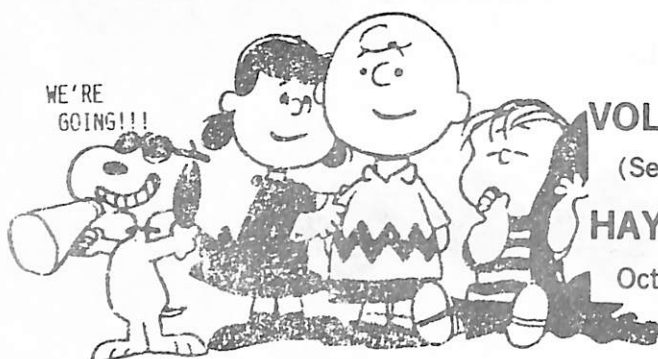
Learn how to pour candles. Make your own special candle. Many different kinds of candles can be made. Class will be open to both youth and adults.

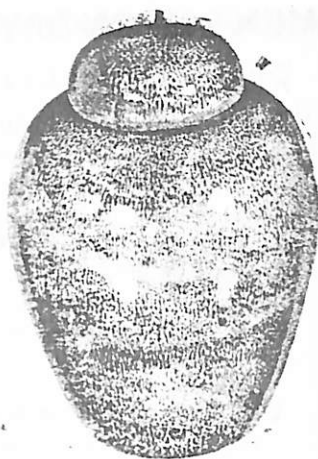

Team 2—11th & 12th grade

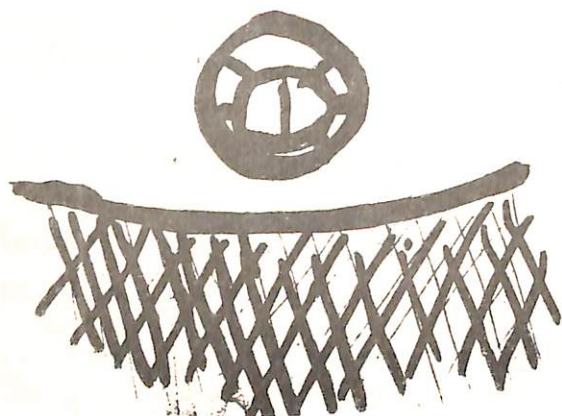

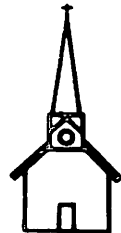
(11) AFTER CHURCH FELLOWSHIPS

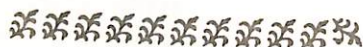
OCTOBER
