Native Called To

London Pastorate

Late in March 1911, Dr. Amzi Clarence Dixon who had been born and reared in Shelby received a call to become pastor of the Metropolitan Tabernacle in London, England, a pulpit formerly held by the noted Charles H. Spurgeon, powerful evangelist.

Dr. Dixon accepted from Chicago where he was pastor of the Dwight L. Moody Tabernacle, largest church in the Windy City. He was the son of the late Thomas Dixon, pioneer Baptist minister in this county for more than 60 years.
