In view of Judge Webb's long and faithful service to the institution, it is considered appropriate to observe this occasion during commencement week just after the trustees have completed their annual session.


As a relative of Judge Webb, you are cordially invited to attend this celebration as special guests of the college and local civic clubs. Please indicate your plans by letter at your first convenience.
