We are returning the following:

4 copies of Panel Data. 4 copies of Pixture Schedule.

4 copies of Pire Alarms.

We are inclosing a list of changes to the Lighting Fixtures. We believe this to be clear enough but let me know if it is not. Some fixtures have been omitted and some changed. Note the lantern, instead of wall brackets for the Portico. It seems that the Corridors and Toilet Vestibules were overlighted for this type of building. Also that plain porcelain receptacles are good enough for the Mechanical Room and Closets. Please change your order accordingly. Check quantities.

These changes were made before the order was confirmed and before any roughing was done. We would like for this to result in a credit for the College, to the extent which is fair to both parties. Please itemize the additions and deductions to your original Contract and let us know what the credit amount should be at your earliest convenience. If you have any comments about these changes, we shall be glad to hear from you.

I am still trying to get exact information from the Telephone Company, so that you can install underfloor conduit and make ready for the floor slab. The Console Desk in the Foyer and Telephone Cabinets in the Office back of the Desk control all campus phones, with provision for future growth. The Telephone Company in Gastonia has been working on this for over a month and still has not been able to answer all questions. As soon as I do have the information, I will make a drawing showing how this telephone work must be done to assure a satisfactory installation.

CHANGES IN LIGHTING FIXTURES:

Mechanical Room:

1. Change 6 "G" fixtures to 6 plain porcelain receptacles with 75 W.I.F.

First Floor:

2. Portico: Omit the 2 wall brackets "C" and wall outlets for these. Install 1 NL 7751 hanging lantern, 16" size, 40" body length, with 20" of chain. Finish to be black and brass. 1 - 150 W.F.F. Locate ceiling box as directed by the Architect.

3. Foyer-Reception: Omit 1 "B", 2 "I" and 2 "J" fixtures. Add 3 "A" fixtures to Foyer for total of 6 "A". See sketch.

4. Corridor: Change 5 "A" to 5 "B". 1st fixture to center on the 2 "A" fixtures by Foyer and on Corridor fixtures. Fixtures to be 12'-0" apart, 14'-0" on center.

5. Stair: Change fixture, under landing from 1 "A" to 1 "B".

6. Womens Toilet: Change 1 "A" to 1 "B".

7. Toilet Vestibule: Change 1 "B" to 1 "L" with 75 W.I.F.

Closets (3): Change 3 "E" to 3 plain porcelain receptacles

Second Floor:

with 75 W.I.P.

- 9. Staff Lounge: Omit the 2 "M" fixtures.
- 10. Corridor: Change 7 "A" to 7 "B" fixtures. Locate as directed.
- 11. Stair: Place lights 4'-0" apart. Locate as directed.
- 12. Mens Toilet: Change 1 "A" to 1 "B" fixtures. Locate as directed.
- 13. Toilet Vestibule: Change 1 "B" to 1 "L" with 75 W.I.F.
- 14. Closets (2): Change 1 "E" and 1 "L" to 2 plain porcelain receptacles with 75 W.I.F.
