



To Mr. L. Webb Greeting:

We, reposing special trust and confidence in your prudence, ability, and learning in the law, do by these presents appoint and commission you a Judge of our Superior Courts for the Twelfth Judicial District, to succeed Mr. W. C. Hoke resigning; your term of office beginning at 12 o'clock mid night November 14th 1884 and do authorize you, after taking the oath required by law for your qualification, to enter upon the said office and discharge all the duties thereof, until your successor shall be elected and qualified, and do hereby confer upon you all the rights, privileges and powers useful and necessary to the just discharge of said office, and authorize you to receive and enjoy the emoluments arising therefrom.

our Governor and Commander-in-Chief, hath signed with his hand these presents and caused our Great Seal to be affixed thereto.
