



To James L. Webb Greeting:

We, reposing special trust and confidence in your *prudence*, ability, and learning in the law, do by these presents appoint and commission you a Judge of our Superior Courts for the Sixteenth Judicial District, *of 8 years* for a term beginning on the first day of January, 1915, and ending upon the election and qualification of your successor

and do authorize you, after taking the oath required by law for your qualification, to enter upon the said office and discharge all the duties thereof, until your successor shall be elected and qualified, and do hereby confer upon you all the rights, privileges and powers useful and necessary to the just discharge of said office, and authorize you to receive and enjoy the emoluments arising therefrom.

In Witness Whereof, His Excellency LOCKE CRAIG

our Governor and Commander-in-Chief, hath signed with his hand these presents and caused our Great Seal to be affixed thereto.

Done at our City of Raleigh, this 29th day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and 14, and in the one hundred and 39th year of our American Independence.
