PROCEEDINGS

The Kings Mountain Baptist Association met in its Sixty-ninth annual session with the Sandy Plains Baptist Church, in Cleveland County North Carolina, on the 24th, 25th and 26th days of September 1919.

Wednesday, September 24th

The Association began its sessions by singing "How Firm A Foundation" and our "Campaign Song" followed with prayer led by Brother Z. D. Harrill.

Devotional exercise being numerous scripture quotations and voluntary prayers.

On motion, it was ordered that this sessions of the Association be run 30 minutes slow of standard time.

At 11 o'clock, J. W. Suttle, Moderator called the Association to order and appointed Brethren J. H. Trott, J. P. Mull and J. W. Irvin, to distribute cards for the enrollment of delegates and upon a canvass of the cards, it was found that all the churches in the Association were represented, with a total enrollment of 162 delegates.

On motion the rules were suspended and the following officers were elected by acclamation: J. W. Suttle, Moderator, Jno. P. Mull, Vice Moderator, J. J. Lattimore, Clerk and Geo. Blanton, Treas.

On Motion Brother J. M. Kester was added to the committee on order of business.

The following visitors were recognized: Brethren Z. D. Harrill, B. M. Bridges and D. J. Hunt of the Sandy Run Association, Fuller Hamrick, of the Orphanage, A. G. Melton, of Rockingham, J. J. Waldrop, of the South Fork Association, and W. T. Tate, of Sandy Run Association. Dr. R. T. Vann, representing Christian Education.

At 11:15, Brother W. R. Beach, the appointee, proceeded to preach the Introductory Sermon, his text being a part of the 9th verse of the 16th chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, "Come over into Macedonia and help us. This subject he very ably handled and was very much enjoyed by the large audience, following which Brother J. L. McCurry led in prayer.

"Resolved that the Association ask each church within the next year to revise its roll of members and request the members living nearer another Baptist Church to secure their letters and join that church." On motion same was

adopted.

The association adjourned to meet to-morrow morning at 10 o'clock.

Thursday Morning

The association met, according to order of adjournment, at 10 o'clock, Brother A. C. Irvin conducting devotional exercise.

Cherryville, Shady Grove, Bessemer City and Mt. Zion Churches, asked for letters of dismission to join the Gaston County Association, and on motion letters were granted.

This being the day set apart for the 75 million campaign, the Moderator called Brother J. M. Kester, Associational Chairman of the Campaign to the chair to preside during the day. The following reports were read and discussed:

State Missions by Brother D. G. Washburn; Home Missions by Brother D. F. Putnam; Foreign Missions by Brother W. R. Beach; Woman's Work by Brother David P. Dellinger; Orphanage by Brother O. M. Mull; Christian Education by Brother J. V. Devenny; Report of the Trustees of Boiling Springs High School by Brother J. H. Quinn and Ministerial Relief Report by Brother J. D. Bridges.

The committee on Time and Place made the following report:

Your committee on Time and Place and Preacher, beg to recommend that the Association hold its session for the year 1920, with Ross Grove Church, beginning on Wednesday before Fourth Sunday in September, and that Brother J. M. Kester be appointed to preach the opening sermon with Brother W. G. Moore as Alternate.

The association met at 10'clock, according to order of adjournment; Devotional Exercise being conducted by Brother I. D. Harrill.

Brother J. N. Barnette read the report on Sunday Schools, Brethren Z. R. Walker, D. J. Keeter and J. N. Barnett were appointed delegates to the State Convention.

Brother J. W. Suttle was appointed delegate to the Southern Baptist Convention with Brother J. M. Kester as alternate.

The committee appointed to recommend an executive committee, recommended Brethren J. W. Suttle, D. G. Washburn, A. C. Irvin, H. D. Wilson and R. L. Weathers,

which was adopted.

Brother Jno. P. Mull offered resolutions tendering our thanks to the good people of Sandy Plains Church for the royal manner in which we were entertained. Same was adopted by a rising vote.

Brother J. M. Kester was appointed Vice President of Foreign Mission Board; Brother D. F. Putnam, Vice President of the State Mission Board and Brother D. G. Washburn, Vice President of the Home Mission Board.

Brother J. W. Suttle was appointed a member of the Board of State Missions, expense to be paid by the Association.

Brother J. M. Goode read the report on Obituaries.

On motion of Brother A. C. Irvin, the association adjourned to meet with the Ross Grove Church on Wednesday before the fourth Sunday in September 1920.
