One thing Picklesimer is happiest about from her college career is the friends she made. She is also the first person in her family to graduate from college and she knows they are all proud of her.

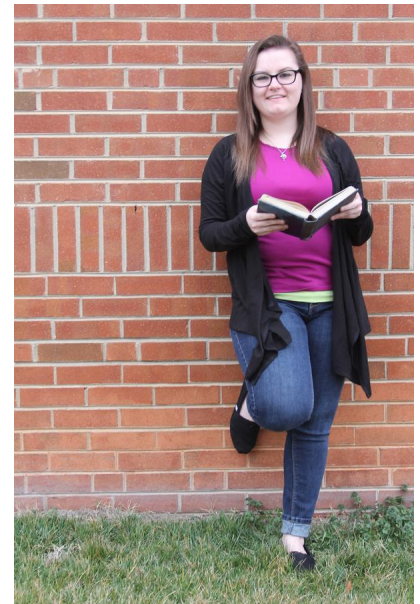
