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Diakolios mentioned Campus Pizzeria, since the location would be literally right across the road from Gardner-Webb.

They have a variety of Greek and Italian food to offer. Specialty pizzas, wings, burgers, subs, salads, baked lasagna, and calzones are just a few to mention. "All of our wing sauce, marinara sauce, our dough and desserts are homemade," said Tsambounieris.

Their slogan states, "You've had the rest, now enjoy the best!" Campus Pizzeria prepares their food and cooks it to order.

Campus Pizzeria stands out from other restaurants by their names of menu items. "The [names of] items on our menu are things about Gardner-Webb," said Tsambounieris. For example, there is a specialty pizza called "The Bulldog" which includes pepperoni, ham, bacon, sausage, ground beef, pizza sauce and mozzarella.

Others specialty pizza names are the Dorm Special, The Winnings Score, Study Hall, Professor and Campus; all of which have different combinations of toppings.

The food, though, is not the only thing they take pride in. Campus Pizzeria is a family owned and operated restaurant. Louie Tsambounieris is Anna Tsambounieris' uncle.
