Accelerated Master's Program Experiences Exponential Growth

BOILING SPRINGS, N.C.—The first students in the 10-month Master of Business Administration (MBA) program at Gardner-Webb University will finish in October. From its launch in January, interest in the master's degree offered fully online has exceeded expectations.


"We are excited about the continued growth of the 10-month MBA program," assessed Mischia Taylor, dean of the GWU Godbold School of Business and instructor of business. "We have a diverse group of students, who are either looking to advance their career, are lifelong learners or are recent graduates. We were slightly surprised at the demand, and the number of applicants has been well above plan."

Dr. Christine Sutton, assistant professor of business, taught the capstone course, which integrates everything the students have learned previously. She believes that accelerating the MBA

program has enhanced both the 10-month and traditional MBA curricula. "I'm a huge fan of efficiency, and I feel we have streamlined it," she observed. "It improves the program to be able to think through what is essential and align the learning goals. Our classes were good before, but now they are better because any time you take another in-depth look at something, you are going to have improvements."

Semesters are eight weeks, and students enroll in two courses each session. This format appealed to Jenny Maybin, who received an associate's degree in office administration and transferred to Gardner-Webb to complete her bachelor's in business administration. She said the 10-month MBA came along at the right time for her. "I was trying to figure out how I was going to complete my degree before my wedding in April," Maybin related.
