Charles Schlueter to Offer Free Distinguished Artist Show in Blanton Auditorium on Jan.

17

BOILING SPRINGS, N.C.—World-class trumpet player Charles Schlueter returns to Gardner-Webb University for a free performance Jan. 17 at 3 p.m. in Blanton Auditorium. Schlueter served as principal trumpet for the Boston Symphony Orchestra for more than 25 years and has previously visited GWU to offer both a concert and masterclass for the public.

In a half century of orchestra experience, Schlueter performed with the Kansas City Philharmonic, Milwaukee Symphony, Minnesota Orchestra and Cleveland Orchestra. He also established himself as a distinguished soloist and teacher, offering masterclasses on four continents.

During his upcoming visit to GWU, Schlueter will perform along with GWU collaborative piano/Distinguished Artist Cynthia Clyburn Swicegood, GWU Assistant Professor of Music Tim Hudson, High Point University Professor of Trumpet Rusty Smith, and University of South Carolina Professor of Trumpet James Ackley.
