Industrial Relations Association presents Employer Update: HR (Human Resources) Compliance and Trends. The seminar designed for churches, business owners, managers, and HR professionals will be held Thursday, Oct. 17 from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. in GWU's Tucker Student Center.
