BOILING SPRINGS, N.C. – The Gardner-Webb University Gayle Bolt Price School of Graduate Studies will be hosting several events to showcase programs they have to offer. Participants will have the chance to go one on one with students and faculty members, while learning about programs offered. Events will be held at Stewart Hall, located in the Tucker Student Center.

The first event is a Graduate School Fair meant primarily for undergraduate students on Thursday, Feb. 7 from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.

“We want to make sure our undergraduate students are aware of what we offer,” said Lamont Reeves, director of Graduate Admissions. “Especially if they are considering moving on to grad school.”

The second event, a Graduate Information Session for Working Professionals, takes place on Monday, Feb. 18 from 6 – 8 p.m.

“This event open to the public is for those who work during the day. It gives them the opportunity to come in the evening and explore what the grad school has to offer,” said Reeves.

The last event is a Graduate Open House, a full campus experience, on Saturday, March 23 from 10 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Assistant Director for Graduate Admissions Amanda Chapman says, “These events will also enable visitors to learn about financial aid options, and take the guesswork out of the admissions process. Students will be able to gain an understanding of what it feels like to be a part of the Gardner-Webb community.”
