The guest panelists were Dr. Jim McConnell, Bob D. Shepherd Chair of Biblical Studies, associate dean of the School of Divinity and professor of New Testament interpretation, and Dr. Meredith Greene Rowe, an assistant professor of biology. The discussion was recorded live in front of an

audience of students, who were given an opportunity to ask questions at the end.



McConnell teaches classes in all areas of the New Testament as well as biblical Greek. The author of

Cell Biology and Immunology. Her areas of interest are Translational Science and Osteoarthritis. McConnell and Rowe shared their own personal beliefs about faith and its relationship with science.

"The topos of Divine Testimony in Luke-Acts," as well as other articles and essays, McConnell focuses

especially on Luke-Acts and Paul. Rowe typically teaches Human Biology, Anatomy & Physiology,




