on Aug. 19. Gardner-Webb's total fall enrollment—in undergraduate, Degree Completion and graduate programs—is approximately 3,500, with nearly 1,200 students living on campus. "We're excited for these new Runnin' Bulldogs to join us, and we have great things in store for them," noted Gardner-Webb President Dr. William M. Downs. "Their GWU journey is just beginning, and we

commit to making it an exceptional and rewarding experience."



While holding the line on tuition costs, several other financial incentives were offered, such as the Foothills Commitment to residents of Cleveland, Gaston and Rutherford counties, and the expansion of church-matching and minister's dependent scholarships. "We targeted specific communities and regions in the southeast with financial incentives and especially
