
Some of the information from her article, "Audit Evidence Concept, Classification and Collection <u>Techniques in China and the U.S.</u>," will be used in her dissertation on audit issues. "The DBA program at Gardner-Webb has a good reputation and is challenging," Yin described. "My area is accounting, but I also have to learn other business major courses, such as economics, international business, finance, statistics, marketing, management, etc. With this compact schedule, I will have knowledge of business in different perspectives, which will be beneficial for my further research. 
