The Honor Roll (<https://gardner-webb.edu/about/offices-and-departments/office-of-the-registrar/honor-roll/>) is composed of undergraduate college students with a grade point average of 3.5 who are enrolled for 12-14 hours with no grade below a "C" or students with a grade point average of 3.2 who are enrolled for 15 or more hours with no grade below a "C."
