Mr. Perrin made an assignment on the 13th of January and I went to work for Mr. Speed the next day. I like the place much better. It is a nice store and we keep it warm all the time. I have not suffered with cold since I have been here. I am doing very well, still coughing a good deal. I am taking Powell's Cod Liver Oil Beef & Pepsin. I think it is doing me good. I still have to sleep on my right side and it worries me a great deal. I received a letter from Sam a few days ago. He says he is still out of a job. Give Miss Bettie my best regards and tell Kate howdy for me. Tell Quill I will answer her letter in a few days. Tell Kanse to write to me. Have not heard from you in a long time.
