Submitting Your Manuscript

The *Journal of Organizational and Educational Leadership (JOEL)* is a double-blind peer-reviewed journal published by the School of Education at Gardner-Webb University. Focused on K-12 education and educators as well as senior leaders responsible for organizational learning, *JOEL* focuses on empirical and conceptual studies, including original research and evaluation studies, and informed opinion in and about organizational and educational practice. From the *JOEL* homepage left menu tab, select Submit Article, and Create New Account. From there, just follow the instructions to submit your manuscript.

What We Look For

Most published articles are up to 7,500 words, written in a scholarly style, covering issues pertinent to K–12 educators and organizational learning leaders. Some qualities we look for include:

- Papers describing research-based solutions to current problems of practice in education.
- Program evaluations and evaluation studies and their local or organizational impact.
- Reasoned, articulate, research-informed opinion on controversial subjects.

How to Prepare Your Manuscript

We use the reference style outlined by the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association*, Sixth Edition. Exception: Authors will use Arial 11-point font for all narrative. Tables and figures should be in Arial 9-point font. Authors bear full responsibility for the accuracy of citations, quotations, figures, and facts. Be sure to adhere to the following guidelines:

- Include an abstract of no more than 150 words.
- Include no more than five tables or figures and a maximum 40 references.
- Paginate and double-space all copy and leave generous margins.
- Include your name, address, phone number, and e-mail address on the cover sheet.
- Identify the number of words in the manuscript, including tables, figures, and references.
- Authorization to publish relinquishing property rights to *JOEL* and Gardner-Webb

What Happens Next

Your manuscript will be read using a double-blind peer-review process. Research and evaluation studies are critiqued in terms of significance, conceptualization, methodological soundness, discussion quality, overall scholarship, and appropriateness for *JOEL*. When reviewing opinion-based articles, we will consider factors such as balance of perspectives, locations, topics, scholarship, and quality of argument. You will be notified regarding the status of your manuscript. Manuscript selections are tentative until we go to press.
